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Food & Beverage: Enclosed is a list of possible menu selections. The listed items are by no means the limit of what our Culinary Team can create for your event. We can also accommodate vegetarian, vegan & gluten free meals. We would be pleased to assist you in designing a menu to best accommodate your needs. Per TABC regulations all alcoholic beverages must be supplied through The Battleground Golf Couse. Donated Non-alcohol is permitted however service charges will apply.

Guarantee: Player Counts & Additional Food Counts: Your final guaranteed players list and food count is due seven (7) days prior to your event date. Custom printing of cart tags, score cards and rules sheets will be run 48 hours prior. All contests & special formats must also be communicated by this time. Player & food counts may be increased but cannot decrease after this time.

Deposit & Payments: To confirm your date reservation, an initial deposit of 25% of your estimate will be due at signing of your contract. The remaining final balance & final count will be due 3 days prior to your event date. Charges are based on final guarantees or number in attendance whichever is greater.

Cancellation: All deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable. Deposits and payments can be made by credit card, check or cash. Final payments may not be made via personal check. In the event of inclement weather and the tournament cannot be played, The Battleground will transition your deposit to an event taking place within a 6 month window.

Pricing, Service Charge & Tax: Prices are subject to a 21% club service charge & Texas state sales tax at the current rate. Menus are subject to change with seasonality and availability. Your tournament representative will alert you of any changes. The Battleground Golf Course houses several events & reserves the right to hold multiple events on any given day.

At the Club House/Course: We ask that you not affix anything to the interior or exterior clubhouse or golf course without approval from the course management. All cooking trailers and/or food vendors must be be assigned & located at the discretion of the course management. Client at commencement of the event must remove all signage, tents & property brought to the venue. The Battleground Golf Course is NOT responsible for any items that are left at the club.

Rentals: Third party event rentals must be approved by The Battleground Golf Course. All vendors must carry proper licensing & insurance. All rentals should be of professional quality and receive prior approval from the course management.

Liability: The Battleground Golf Course is not responsible for any damage or loss to any merchandise, articles or valuables belonging to the host, guest or vendors. The host is responsible for any damages incurred to the club, including those involving the use of any independent contractor arranged by the host or their representative.
